We will also be learning to write instructions and non-chronological reports.</p> <p>Moreover, the children will work on writing sentences with capital letters and full stops and to add detail (describing words and nouns) to their work.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>In Numeracy, year 1 will be looking at how to tell time to the hour and half past the hour. They will be sequencing events in order using key words such as today, yesterday, tomorrow, morning, afternoon and evening. Year 1 will be adding and subtracting one and two digit numbers,</p> <p>measuring length and height, multiplying, dividing and learning about fractions (halves and quarters).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE</u></p> <p>In P.E we will be doing gymnastic sequencing to explore movements and actions with control and link them together with flow. The children will also be looking similarities between festivals in Judaism and in other faiths. Lastly, they will be understanding the importance of festivals in their own lives and in the lives of Jewish people.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>In Science, year 1 will learn about 'Everyday Materials'.</p> <p>The children will explore a range of different types of materials. We will be naming them and comparing them to each other as well as discussing what materials are suitable for different objects.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>In Music, Year 1 will be continuing with their African Drumming lessons.
