Enalish

In English the children will be reading a range of books about castles, dragons and knights. They will continue to learn how to use different reading strategies in their reading. We will also retell stories, write instructions and information texts. The children will continue to write sentences with capital letters and full stops and to use different sentence starters to their work.

Mathematics

In Mathematics, year 1 will be looking at place value. Counting to and from 0 and 100 (or beyond). They will revisit all four operations that they have learnt: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be introducing money and measurement weight and volume.

PE

In P F we will be doing Ball Games.

The children will learn to bounce, kick, roll and throw a range of different balls in games.
