

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be studying three genres: narrative, non-fiction and poetry.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Narrative:</b></p> <p>Our main text is 'Stone Girl, Bone Girl' in the Autumn 1 Term and 'The Pied Piper of Hamelin' in the Autumn 2 Term. We will look at settings and how to set the scene for our stories; character profiles and features of strong characters we often find in stories; we will look at techniques to build the suspense in stories and how our stories can be resolved with a good ending.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Non-fiction:</b></p> <p>We will analyse information texts and write our own non chronological reports about Stone Age life</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Poetry:</b></p> <p>We will explore different forms of poetry as well as aspects of performance.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Mathematics</u></b></p> <p>The main focus this Autumn Term will be on number in which we will be learning the following:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Number and Place Value</b></p> <p>Counting from 0 in 50s and 100s. Recognising the value of a digit in 3 /4/5 digit numbers. <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>RE</u></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>The Bible</u></b></p> <p>In RE pupils will learn about the Bible as the source of authority for Christians, its background and context. They will also learn about what Jesus taught and told people to do and how Christians can relate Jesus' s teachings to their own questions of values and attitudes.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>P.E.</u></b></p> <p>Children will have swimming lessons on Wednesdays and PE now on Tuesdays. Autumn 1 Term– Multi-skills Autumn 2 Term– Dance (African)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Rocks and Fossils</b></p> <p>During this topic, the children will learn to describe and compare different types of rocks and explore how and why rocks change over time. They will also investigate whether rocks let water through them (permeability).</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Animals, including Humans</b></p> <p>The children will learn to identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Art &amp; DT</u></b></p> <p>In Art we will be finding out about Cave painting during the Stone Age and creating our own paintings using paint we will make from natural sources (fruit, limestone, vegetables and egg yolk)</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>D&amp;T– Bronze Age jewellery</u></b></p> <p>We will look at jewellery from the bronze age, both the design and how it fastened. We will design and make our own piece of jewellery.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Music</u></b></p> <p>Year 3 children will be listening and singing songs, concentrating on finding the pulse in the music and holding one rhythmic part against another one.</p>

We will focus on Europe (including the location of Russia) and North and South America, concentrating on their environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries, and major cities.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>History- Stone Age to the Bronze Autumn 1</u></b></p> <p>We will be studying the period in history from the Stone Age to the Bronze Age. The children will be learning about what life was like for Stone Age man, from hunting, foraging and cooking techniques, how they made their clothes and where they lived. We will look at how the discovery of Bronze changed how people lived.
