We will be learning to write Explanation Texts linked to our topic 'From Farm to Fork' and our science, which is all about Plants.</p> <p>We will also be reading and learning to write biographies.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Mathematics</u></b></p> <p>In maths this half term the children will be learning the four operations—addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be learning about angles and 2D shapes as well as doing some work on 3D shapes. The children will be learning about how change can be difficult, and the life of Zacchaeus. They will also learn about the Parable of the Bread (Mathew 13:33) and how something simple can create a big change, and how this can be a metaphor for how we live our life.</p> <p>We will link our learning in RE with our topic, looking at how seeds change and the metamorphosis of the caterpillar. Finally we will learn about the life of Mother Theresa</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>In science, our topic is plants. We will dissect seeds, plants and flowers. We will learn about how they are structures and the jobs different parts of the plants do. We will also learn about what needs seed to germinate and grow strong and healthy. We will be learning how to plan and carry out a fair test.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Music</u></b></p> <p>In Music, we will be continuing to sing in 2 parts and sing rounds. They will look at food labels and nutritional information. They will design their own soup recipe and packaging.</p>
