


<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>The children will be extending their mental and written strategies in addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. Children will develop their understanding of negative numbers and will improve their ability to solve problems with decimals and fractions. They will have the opportunity to analyse data and improve their understanding of measurement. The pupils will continue to have the opportunity to apply their maths skills to real life situations and to work on a variety of different problem solving activities.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Pupils will be using the story 'The Vanishing Rainforest' by Richard Platt and Rupert Van Wyk as a stimulus for their English work. Pupils develop their skills in being able to write persuasively and to produce a clear discussion text. We will be revisiting the punctuation of direct speech and pupils will also have the opportunity to produce some short play scripts. In Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation pupils will continue to develop their skills in using expanded noun phrases, punctuating fronted adverbial phrases correctly and will continue to build on their understanding of different spelling patterns.</p>	<p>R.E.</p> <p>This term in R.E, Year 4 will be learning about Hinduism. They will be investigating the key believes of Hindus and will compare Hinduism with other religions.</p> <p><u>Science</u></p> <p>In Science pupils will be learning about Animals and Humans.
