

Maths

This term children will learn about angles, shape and measure. Pupils will learn how to use a protractor and will learn how to calculate missing angles in a range of contexts. Pupils will also have the opportunity to recap prime numbers and will extend their understanding of perimeter and area.

English

In English, Year 5 will be using Alfred Noyes' *The Highwayman* to extend their understanding of poetry. Pupils will have the opportunity to write their own narrative poems and to perform during our class assembly.
