

Maths

This term our main focus in maths will be the place value of numbers up to 1 000 000. Children will learn to read, write, identify and compare numbers to 1 000 000. As well as this pupils will spend a substantial amount of time deepening their understanding of addition and subtraction with numbers up to 1 000 000. Excitingly, this term sees the return of Enterprise Week where Year 5 will be using their maths skills to make as much money for charity as possible.

English

In English, Year 5 will be using Charles Dickens' *Oliver Twist* as the context of their English work. Pupils will continue to work on Spelling and Grammar with a particular focus on how to identify and use different complex sentences. Pupils will have the opportunity to deepen their reading skills through *Oliver Twist*. Additionally, they will develop their writing skills through writing character descriptions, describing settings and even writing their own short story about a Victorian child.

R.E.

This term in R.E, Year 5 will be learning about creation. The pupils will look at what Christians believe about how the world is made and will also have the opportunity to talk about how we can take better care of the world around us.

Science
