Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to wish all of our families a safe holiday and a Happy Easter! Please do visit the school website for some Easter activities and competitions.

School re-opens for all pupils on **Tuesday 13th April 21**. From this date, all children should be in full, correct uniform, except on PE days when they should be in full, correct PE kits. Please do check your child's clothing and footwear against the uniform list.

**NHS Track & Trace**

As a school, we once again have to support the NHS Track and Trace system during the Easter holidays. To support me with the requirements from the NHS, to be available for track and trace, I need for you to follow these important steps. If your child has symptoms of COVID between school closing on Friday 26th March and school re-opening for pupils on Tuesday 13th April you must:

1. Contact NHS 111 via telephone or the website to seek advice and to obtain a test.
2. Send a text message to 07742981451, with your child's full name, class and contact telephone number for yourself, to notify me that your child has symptoms and to notify me of the advice given by NHS track and trace.
3. Where NHS advise is for your child to be tested, you must then send another text message to 07742981451 once you receive the test results, regardless of if the results are positive or negative.

We will publicise the text number on the school website. Please note that this number is not to be used for any other purposes.

Please note that if a pupil or adult at our school tests positive, we will only be able to notify the close contacts we know of in our school. If you know your child has been mixing with other children or people outside of school, you must notify NHS Track and Trace. This is vital in reducing transmissions in our community.
