

Centurion – a Roman army captain


**Healing** – when a person who was sick is made well again by the power of God Leper


**Miracle** – supernatural act that is not humanly possible.

**Tax Collector** – a person who collected people's money, who was generally not well-liked

**Disciples** – Jesus' special friends who followed him

**Saviour** – a person who saves others from danger (Christians believe Jesus **saves** people from the consequences of their 'sins' and brings them life in all its fullness).
